LSP offers a variety of educational experiences for learners of all ages, including walks, tours, lectures, and hands-on outdoor activities and laboratory exercises. Programs can be tailored to fit your content needs and address multiple Next Generation Science Standards.



LSP provides a unique opportunity to observe wetland, freshwater, short grass prairie and long grass prairie habitats all within a 22 acre site. The diversity of the park supports a

surprisingly large number of wildlife that call LSP their home.

The programs at LSP emphasize sustainability and stewardship of our freshwater resources through

themes such as Great Lakes history, water ecology, water quality. urban wildlife, prairie ecology, birds, insects, fish & other customizable subjects. The majority of the programs are able to be completed within a two



hour time frame, with the option to complete multiple programs for longer field trips.
